The Executive of the Canadian-American Theological Association (CATA) welcomes proposals for papers to be presented at the May 27, 2018 Annual Meeting to be held in conjunction with the Canadian Congress of the Humanities and Social Sciences at the University of Regina, in Regina, SK.

CATA encourages submission of high quality papers on any topic of theological relevance to the church. Papers are welcome on this year's Congress theme "Gathering Diversities" (<https://www.uregina.ca/congress2018/theme.html>), although this is not a requirement.

This theme suggests bringing people together in the spirit of building community. It honours the history of the area as a traditional place of gathering, evoked in Regina's original name, Wascana, or *oskana kâ-asastêki*—where the bones are gathered—referring to the region's heritage as buffalo hunting grounds for a multitude of Plains cultures. The University's main campus is situated on Treaty Four land and nestled in Canada's largest urban park, called Wascana Park.

Papers for the CATA meeting should be scholarly but not highly specialized presentations of 20–25 minutes, aimed at an audience of scholars from across the spectrum of theological disciplines. We are interpreting *theology* to include biblical studies; theological readings of Scripture; historical, systematic, philosophical, moral, and pastoral theology; theology that engages culture, the church, and other academic disciplines, etc. Proposals from graduate students are welcome.

Proposals should be approximately 250 words in length. Please prepare them for blind review and submit as an email attachment, accompanied by a short CV in a separate file. To facilitate anonymous review of proposals, please include your name, institutional affiliation, contact information, *and the title of your proposal* in the body of your email.

All proposals should be submitted electronically **by January 31, 2018** to the address below in *DOC, *ODT, or *RTF format. Please entitle your email "CATA Congress 2018 Paper Proposal." Papers chosen for participation will be notified by the end of February 2018.
